## President's Message

A little quiet time at the hall this month has allowed the CHCA board to turn our attention to planning and solving longer term issues around our community. Here's a quick summary of recent developments:

## 1. Playground equipment update at Crescent Park - fundraising opportunities

My fellow board member Kellee Grounds is heading up this project. We were told last fall that the City will be replacing the fixtures at this playground as it was built with treated wood that might be of health concerns for children playing on them. A process has been put in place with the Calgary Parks Foundation to help us administer all donations - which will be matched dollar for dollar with grants - made to this project. Tax receipts will also be provided for donations for this project in our community. Kellee has done up an excellent brochure to summarize our options and estimated costs. Look for it soon in the next newsletter or online at our community website.

We are hoping to have community members come together to help with the actual construction / assembly of the equipment once the final structures are ordered and delivered. The last time we had to put together the playground in Rotary Park, we had great community participation, and we are hoping for a repeat performance this time around. Please contact us with you ideas and/or if you are able to help on this project.

#### 2. Fence around the splash park in Rotary Park

Since its opening a couple years back, the splash park has been a big hit with children in our community, and more and more, children from surrounding communities. Too bad that Calgary's summer is only too short, and for the remainder of the year, we do not get much further use of this excellent facility.

As it is a valuable public asset of Crescent Heights, we need to protect it year-round. That is the reason that the splash park came with a fence around it - to protect the asset against vandalism and abuse after hours and during the time when the facility is not being used or occupied.

Unfortunately, when the fence was initially installed it also limited access to the existing picnic tables and benches installed within the perimeter. Furthermore, access to the public washrooms were only available to those inside the fenced perimeter. There was a lot of confusion in this regard, and in particular, the hours when washroom access would be available. This resulted in some of our community members questioning why the fence had to be installed at all. Simply put, the fence is there to protect the splash park fixtures and assets! The management of the fence and access to the facilities within need to be better thought through and communicated to our residents.

#### 3. Fencing to separate playground from adjacent off-leash area in Rotary Park

The CHCA and adjacent residents have always agreed that there is a need for a fence to provide physical separation between the off-leash area to the west from the playground to prevent unintended interactions between dogs and children using the playground. Furthermore, a fence will reduce the chance of fecal contamination of the playground area by dogs roaming out of their owner's direct sight. There was differences in opinions regarding the design of this portion of the fence, and whether the existing one around the splash park needs to be removed and reinstalled to match the new design. In the end, this much needed additional fence sort of fell through the "bureaucratic cracks" and remains unfinished.

The CHCA has restarted the process to get this project to finally wrapped up and see the much needed fence installed. I will keep everyone posted if anything new comes up.

#### 4. Annual Community Clean-up set for Sunday, June 15th

I am pleased to confirm that our annual community clean-up is set for this year, but will be pushed back about three weekends from our often held time of the May Victoria Day long weekend. We will try a later date this year to see if we can increase our participation from community residents. We have been getting good feedback from community users over the years and this has definitely become one of the "must attend" events for many long-term residents.

There were comments that having it held on the Victoria Day long weekend interferes with residents who cherish this first long weekend to be spent with their family and those who are out of town. In the end, the CHCA would like to see increased participation and improved accessibility to this annual event. Also, back for another round-up will be electronics recycling, and the increasingly favourite for many – the household exchange – where lightly used items can be dropped off for exchange and/or donation to charities. We will also look to have a cube van to circulate around our community to help remove larger items for disposal.

Rain or shine, we hope to see you out there at the CHCA hall parking lot on June 15th for this excellent event. If you can help, please give us a call. The more the merrier!

#### 5. AGM set for April 29, 2014

Last but not least, our AGM for this year will be held on April 29th. This is where we can come together to have a quick chat with our residents to openly exchange ideas on pertinent issues surrounding Crescent Heights. Please be sure that you have your community membership renewed or purchased before the date of the AGM.

Finally, the limited space here does not afford me the opportunity to touch on other topics that might be of interest or concern to our readers. Thus, if you have any ideas, suggestions or viewpoints on the above, or any other issues in our community, we would love to hear from you. We thank you for your input.



## Walking in the Woods: A Metis Journey

by Herb Belcourt



Sometimes more recent history is less well known than the history we learned in school. *Walking in the Woods: A Metis Journey* by Herb Belcourt is a memoire that gently unveils the story of Metis families near Edmonton in mid-twentieth century. Written as if he were talking to me in person, the book let me participate in Belcourt's life of both business success and community service.

Today, we would consider that young Herb had a difficult start. He was born in a small log house to parents who worked very hard. His father bought furs and sold them to a broker. As a teenager, Herb left home to work in the logging camps and mines, which meant that he hardly knew some of his younger siblings.

Even so, Herb was organized and had been attentive to his parents' advice, resulting in the establishment of his successful upholstery business. He became his own boss by recognizing a need and meeting it through hard work and savvy practices.

Later he applied the same model in establishing a company that installed and serviced rural telephone lines, and a subsequent company to work on power lines. Even more importantly, he joined two other men to establish a non-profit company providing good houses for urban Metis families at a time when discrimination often forced them into dilapidated accommodations.

In a charming twist on autobiography, Herb Belcourt invited – perhaps cajoled – family members into writing brief recollections of family life and their own experiences. Also included are previously published stories from others in the Metis community, rounding out the usual singular point of view.

Herb Belcourt has been honoured for his leadership and community values, including serving on the Board of Athabasca University and being awarded the Order of Canada. His prominent role in the Edmonton region is not well-known in Calgary, but his story is universal in appeal.


